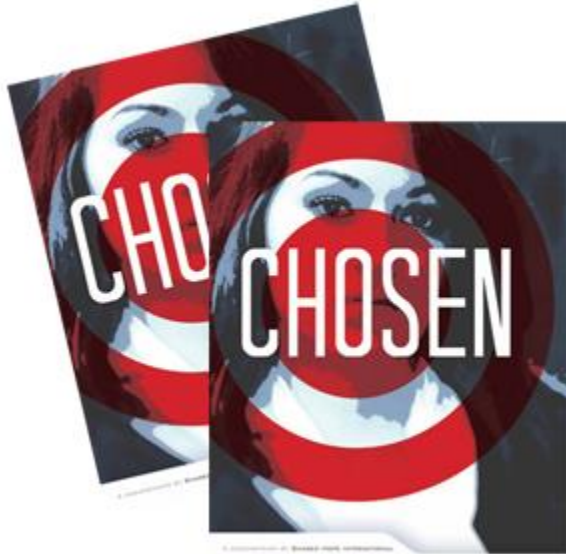


“CHOSEN” TO HONOR THE UN’S WORLD DAY AGAINST TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS



On July 30, 2018, at 7PM, Set Free Dubuque is hosting a free screening of the short film “Chosen – The True Story of America’s Trafficked Teens,” at Statera: Integrated Health and Wellness Solutions in honor of the UN’s World Day Against Trafficking in Persons.

The film focuses on teenage sex trafficking. Following the

screening will be a question and answer session about human trafficking concerns in the Dubuque area.

The screening and Q&A will be facilitated by Suzanne Wright, Executive Director of Set Free Dubuque, which is a non-profit organization seeking to educate the community, advocate for victims, and eliminate the demand for human trafficking.
