Victims are coerced and exploited in the labor industry or sex trade for someone else's gain.

Some victims of exploitation may:

- Be unusually anxious, fearful or submissive
- Work unusually long hours
- Be in debt to an employer
- Be paid below minimum wage or not at all
- Live and work in the same place
- Perform commercial sex for another person's profit

The illegal trade or use of a person against their will for the purpose of forced labor or sexual exploitation.
